Text of article 48 as adopted provisionally by the International  
Law Commission at its 1034th meeting

Article 48

Protection of premises and archives

1. When the permanent mission is temporarily or definitely recalled, the host State must respect and protect the premises as well as the property and archives of the permanent mission. The sending State must take all appropriate measures to terminate this special duty of the host State within a reasonable time.
2. The host State is required to grant the sending State facilities for removing the property and the archives of the permanent mission from the territory of the host State.
