Letter dated 26 February 2015 from the Permanent Representative of the Democratic Republic of the Congo to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to draw the attention of the Security Council to the situation concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo and, specifically, the discussions about the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUSCO).

My Government asks the Security Council not to take action on the report of the Secretary-General and MONUSCO without first having heard the position of the Government of the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

Accordingly, my Government wishes to request that the next meeting of the Council on the Democratic Republic of the Congo and MONUSCO be an open meeting, to allow for the participation of the delegation of the Government of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, which will be led by His Excellency Mr. Raymond Tshibanda N'tungamulongo, Minister for Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation.

My Government would be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
