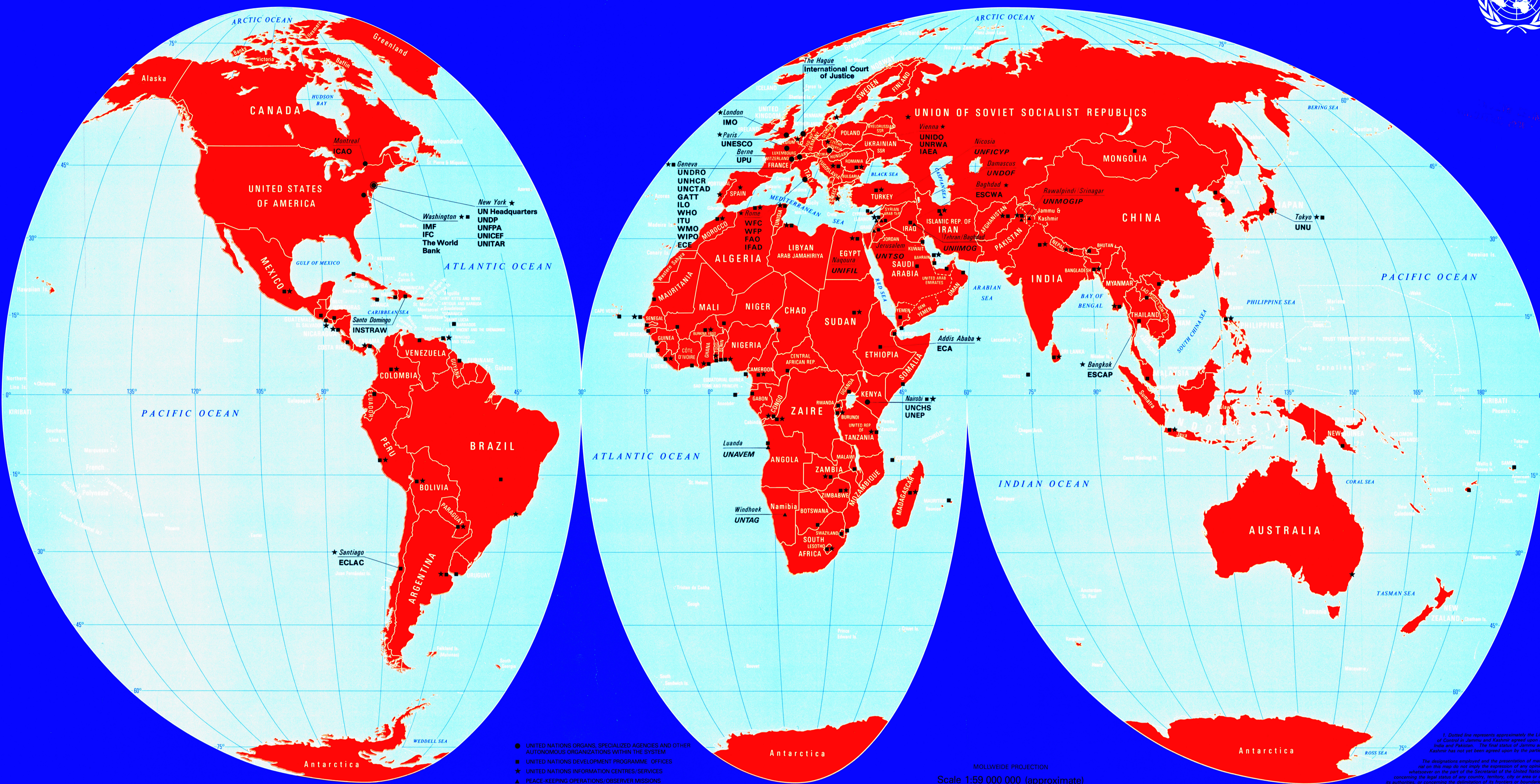


DESCRIPTIVE MAP OF THE UNITED NATIONS
