I wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2015/85, which contains a letter dated 29 January 2015 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council.

Angola, Chad, Chile, China, France, Jordan, Lithuania, Malaysia, New Zealand, Nigeria, Russian Federation, Spain, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of)

The President (*spoke in French*): The draft resolution received 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 2212 (2015).
