APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS

Appointment of members of the Joint Inspection Unit

Note by the President of the General Assembly

- l. As indicated in paragraph 2 of document A/39/107/Add.2, the General Assembly is required to appoint a person to fill a vacancy in the Joint Inspection Unit created by the death of Mr. Toman Hutagalung (Indonesia) on 19 December 1984.
- 2. In accordance with the procedures described in article 3, paragraph 1, of the statute of the Joint Inspection Unit, the President of the General Assembly, having consulted the regional group concerned, determined that Indonesia should be requested to propose a candidate (see annex I).
- 3. The President of the General Assembly has held the further consultations described in article 3, paragraph 2, of the statute of the Joint Inspection Unit, including consultations with the President of the Economic and Social Council and with the Secretary-General in his capacity as Chairman of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination. The replies received from the President of the Council and from the Secretary-General to identical letters addressed to them on 14 March 1985 are attached (see annexes II and III).
- 4. Having completed the required consultations, the President of the General Assembly has the honour to submit to the Assembly the candidature of Mr. Kahono Martohadinegoro (Indonesia) for appointment as member of the Joint Inspection Unit for a five-year term expiring on 31 December 1989.

ANNEX I

Letter dated 25 February 1985 from the Permanent Representative of Malaysia to the United Nations

As Chairman of the Asian Group for the month of February 1985, I have the honour to convey the endorsement of the Asian Group of the nomination by the Indonesian Government of Mr. Kahono Martohadinegoro to fill the vacancy in the Joint Inspection Unit created by the untimely death of Mr. Toman Hutagalung. A copy of the curriculum vitae of Mr. Kahono Martohadinegoro is attached herewith.

In conveying the Asian Group's endorsement for Mr. Kahono Martohadinegoro, I have also been asked to request Your Excellency to reopen the item on the Joint Inspection Unit to enable the General Assembly to consider and endorse the Asian Group's nomination at the reconvened session of the General Assembly which Your Excellency is proposing to hold in April 1985.
