

Letter dated 29 April 2015 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2213 (2015), adopted on 27 March 2015, by which the Council decided to extend until 30 April 2016 the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Libya.

Mr. Simon Dilloway, finance (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)

Mr. Juan Alberto Pintos Servia, maritime/transport (Spain)

Mr. Steven Spittaels, finance/armed groups (Belgium)

Ms. Savannah de Tessières, arms (France)

I have also designated Ms. Savannah de Tessières to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
