Bulgaria, Colombia and Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic:
draft resolution

International campaign against drug abuse and illicit trafficking

The General Assembly,

Believing in human dignity and the legitimate aspirations of human beings for a decent life with moral, humanitarian and spiritual values in a healthy, safe environment,

Deeply concerned with the dimension and gravity of the global problem of drug abuse, which has become deeply rooted in the majority of regions and States of the world and has damaged the health of millions of people, in particular, the youth,

Alarmed by the threat that drug abuse and illicit trafficking pose to the political, economic and social bases of States, their sovereignty and security,

Recalling the Declaration of the International Conference on Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, 1/

Noting that the International Conference on Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, held at Vienna from 17 to 26 June 1987, 1/ and the United Nations

Conference for the Adoption of a Convention against Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, held at Vienna from 25 November to 20 December 1988, 2/ have made great contributions to the implementation of the international campaign against drug abuse and illicit trafficking,

Conscious of the need to raise public awareness through a world-wide campaign against drug abuse and of the further development of co-operation among States in this field on a long-term basis,

Requests the Secretary-General to elaborate a draft programme for a United Nations decade against drug abuse and to report thereon to the General Assembly at its forty-fifth session with a view to the subsequent approval of the draft programme and of the proclamation of a United Nations decade against drug abuse.
