## General Introduction

## SCOPE

1. This Cumulative Index, prepared by the Index Section of the Dag Hammarskjold Library, United Nations, New York, replaces and supersedes - together with the Cumulative Checklist, published in a separate companion volume - the monthly issues of the United Nations Documents Index.

## ARRANGEMENT

2. The Cumulative Index consists of two parts issued separately. Part 1 is a consolidation of the twelve monthly subject indexes. Part 2 contains the following sections:
(a) A consolidated list by symbol of all documents and publications issued by the United Nations, including the International Court of Justice, received by the Library during the year, with an indication of the languages in which they were issued;
(b) A consolidated list of mimeographed documents republished in the printed Official Records and in other publications;
(c) A list of sales publications;
(d) A list of new document series symbols;
(e) A list of libraries and United Nations Information Centres receiving United Nations material.

Where considered necessary, additional explanatory notes introduce the sections.

## MONTHLY ISSUES

3. Each monthly issue of the United Nations Documents Index includes in general the documents and publications processed by the Index Section during the month. The issues of July and August are combined in one issue. Periodicals are listed annually in the Cumulative Checklist.
4. Each issue comprises three separate sections that can be used independently. The first section is a checklist of United Nations documents and publications, arranged by symbol and fully described bibliographically. The second section comprises: (a) a list by symbol only of all United Nations documents received by the Library during the preceding month, with indication of the languages in which they were issued, and notes concerning their availability for distribution. It should be noted that this list includes
language editions of all documents and publications as they are received and is not necessarily limited to those processed and entered in the Checklist; (b) a list of mimeographed documents republished in the printed Official Records and in other publications; (c) a list of sales publications. The third section is a combined author-subject index to the documents described in the Checklist. It is printed on a detachable yellow fascicle and can be removed and used independently of the Checklist.

## CUMULATIVE EDITIONS

5. Beginning with vol. 14 (1963) the monthly issues are superseded at the end of the year by two separate annual cumulations, the Cumulative Checklist and the Cumulative Index.

## avallability of documents and publications

6. Information concerning the documentation system of the United Nations and the availability of the documents is given each year in the January issue in the introductory note preceding the Checklist of Documents and Publications and on page 1 of the Cumulative Checklist. A list of libraries and Information Centres receiving United Nations material is included each year in the Cumulative Index, Part 2.
7. An asterisk (*) is used to indicate documents issued as drafts or preliminary texts subject to revision, or issued in provisional (mimeographed) editions subject to later publication in the printed Official Records or as printed sales publications. These preliminary or prom visional documents are not for general distribution, deposit or sale.

## SUBSCRIPTION

8. The United Nations Documents Index is published monthly at an annual subscription rate of U.S. $\$ 10.00$ (or equivalent in other currencies), post-free, and including the two annual cumulations. Single copies are available at U.S. \$0.75. The annual cumulations are also available separately as sales publications. Subscriptions may be placed with the sales agents of United Nations publications. Orders and inquiries from countries without a sales agent may be addressed to the Sales Section, United Nations, New York, N.Y. 10017, or to the Sales Section, United Nations Office, Geneva, Switzerland.

2. Each mimeographed document bears the same symbol and date in each language edition. If a document is rem published in the printed Official Records or as a sales publication it retains its symbol. In addition to symbols, sales publications also carry a sales number.

Documents relating to two or more organs may bear two or more symbols, one for each organ.

## LIBRARIES

1. The libraries in this list receive material published by the United Nations for the General Assembly and its subsidiary bodies, for the three Councils and their subsidiary organs, and for the Secretariat. (Because the Registry of the International Court of Justice, The Hague, is autonomous in respect of depositary and sales arrangements for Court publications, no indication is made here to specify libraries receiving them. Generally speaking, however, Court depositories include United Nations depository libraries.) The libraries listed receive their material
(a) free, as depository libraries, or
(b) by paid subscription through the Sales Section, or
(c) by paid subscription to the microprint edition in English published by the Readex Microprint Corporation, New York, or
(d) by exchange of publications, or
(e) as official United Nations Information Centres/ Services.
2. Libraries which subscribe or exchange selectively for less than all the Official Records of the General Assembly and the three Councils are not included in the list. The library of the Department of External Relations has been omitted under each country unless the Government (e.g., Norway) has requested its inclusion in the list as a library open to the public.
3. Depository libraries are identified in the first lefthand column of the list by letter " $D$ "; parliamentary depository libraries (some of which may not be open to the public) are identified by letters "PD". Subscribers to the Readex microprint edition are identified in the fourth left-hand column by letter "R".

## RECEIPT OF LIBRARIES: PRINTED PUBLICATIONS

4. Most libraries receive printed publications ("P"). Of these libraries, those which receive only the Official Records are identified by letter "O".

## MIMEOGRAPHED DOCUMENTS

5. Libraries are designated by letter "M" if, in addition to the mimeographed documents issued by the regional economic commission in whose area they are situated, they receive most other mimeographed documents. It should be noted that the bulk of the documents and all of the meeting records remain permanently in mimeographed form in the series of the non-sessional committees of the General Assembly, of all of the committees of the three Councils, of all series of the functional commissions and regional economic commissions of the Economic and Social Council; and that this is likewise so of the series of petitions and communications to the Trusteeship Council and the observations thereon of the Administering Authorities. For this reason, inquirers for such material should be referred only to libraries listed as receiving it ("M").

The reports of commissions to the Economic and Social Council, the reports of committees to the three Councils and the reports of non-sessional committees to the General Assembly will appear in the respective printed Official Records, as supplements or in the annexes. Inquirers for whom such reports are sufficient may be referred to any library receiving printed material ("P"), including those listed as receiving at least the Official Records ("O").

## UNITED NATIONS INFORMATION CENTRES/SERVICES

6. Included in the list are all United Nations Information Centres/Services existing as of 1 June 1966 established outside the Headquarters and the United Nations Office at Geneva. The year of establishment for each centre is given in square brackets ([]). The centres vary considerably in size of collections and extent of services available to the public.
