REQUEST FOR THE INCLUSION OF AN ADDITIONAL ITEM IN THE AGENDA ENTITLED "DECLARATION ON THE DENUCLEARIZATION OF AFRICA": ITEM PROPOSED BY ALGERIA, BURUNDI, CAMEROON, CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC, CHAD, CONGO (BRAZZAVILLE), DAHOMEY, ETHIOPIA, GABON, GHANA, GUINEA, IVORY COAST, KENYA, LIBERIA, LIBYA, MADAGASCAR, MALAWI, MALI, MAURITANIA, MOROCCO, NIGER, NIGERIA, RWANDA, SENEGAL, SIERRA LEONE, SOMALIA, SUDAN, TOGO, TUNISIA, UGANDA, UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC, UNITED REPUBLIC OF TANZANIA, UPPER VOLTA AND ZAMBIA (A/5975)

The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly the inclusion in the agenda of the item entitled "Declaration on the denuclearization of Africa" and its allocation to the First Committee.

REQUEST FOR THE INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL ITEMS IN THE AGENDA ENTITLED "NON-PROLIFERATION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS" AND "THE INADMISSIBILITY OF INTERVENTION IN THE DOMESTIC AFFAIRS OF STATES AND THE PROTECTION OF THEIR INDEPENDENCE AND SOVEREIGNTY": ITEMS PROPOSED BY THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS (A/5976 AND A/5977)

1. Mr. FEDORENKO (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) asked the Committee to come to a decision at once on the two items proposed by Mr. Gromyko, Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, at the 1335th plenary meeting of the General Assembly, in view of the urgency and importance of both of them, and to recommend that the General Assembly consider them in plenary meeting. In support of his request he read out in full the two explanatory memoranda submitted by the Soviet delegation.^{1/}

2. After an exchange of views in which Mr. FEDORENKO (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics), the CHAIRMAN, Mr. VIZCAINO LEAL (Guatemala), Mr. SEYDOUX (France), Mr. YOST (United States of America), Mr. CSATORDAY (Hungary) and Mr. BOUZIRI (Tunisia) took part, the CHAIRMAN proposed that the Committee should abide by the usual procedure and come to a decision on the two items after the two explanatory memoranda had been distributed, i.e., at the meeting scheduled for Monday, 27 September.

It was so decided.

The meeting rose at 3.30 p.m.
