Letter dated 17 June 2015 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that your letter dated 11 June 2015 (S/2015/447), concerning your intention to seek additional staffing positions, including more long-term electoral observers and additional security staff, for the United Nations Electoral Observation Mission in Burundi (MENUB), has been brought to the attention of the members of the Security Council, who took note of the information provided and the intention expressed therein.

They also emphasized that it was important for MENUB to play a more prominent, robust and visible role in following and reporting on the electoral process and, to that end, recalled their reporting requests under Security Council resolution 2137 (2014).
