HUMAN RIGHTS

RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING INTERNATIONAL RESPECT FOR THE
SELF-DETERMINATION OF PEOPLES

India: Amendments to amendments submitted by the United States of America: (A/C.3/L.294) to draft resolution A proposed by the Commission on Human Rights (A/2165) and transmitted by the Economic and Social Council

1. Amendment to United States amendment no. 3: Replace the first operative paragraph by the following: "The States Members of the United Nations shall uphold the principle of self-determination of all peoples and nations,"
2. Amendment to United States amendment no. 4: Replace the second operative paragraph by the following: "The States Members of the United Nations shall recognize and promote the realization of the right of self-determination of all the peoples, including those of non-self-governing and trust territories which are under their administration and shall grant this right to the peoples of such territories according to the particular circumstances of each territory and the freely expressed wishes of the peoples concerned, the wishes of the people being ascertained through a plebiscite under the auspices of the United Nations or other recognized democratic means."
