With regard to the question of scholarships and social welfare experts
within the framework of advisory social welfare services and the technical
assistance programme,

the Catholic International Union for Social Service has noted with
satisfaction the spirit in which this item was treated by the Social Commission
at its seventh session.

It regards as highly satisfactory the co-ordination of the technical
assistance programme with the advisory services programme in the social
welfare field, and continues to stress the need to send scholarship holders
to countries where social problems take a similar form to the form in which
they arise in their own countries. The Catholic International Union for

Social Service would also like to draw the attention of government representatives to the desirability of using the services of non-governmental organizations both in the international sphere and in their respective countries. The non-governmental organizations can be of assistance in guiding and giving information to scholarship holders, in proposing candidates for scholarships to governments and in the assignments of experts.
