With regard to the queation of scholarships and soeial welfure experts within the framcwork of edvisory social welfare sorvices and the technical assistance programme,
the Catholic International Union for Socinl Service has noted with satisfaction the spirit in which this item was treated by the Social Commission at its seventh session.

It regards as highly satisfactory the comordination of the technical assiatance programme with the advisory services prograrme in the social welfare field, and continues to stress the need to sond scholarship holders to countries where social problems take a sinilar form to the form in which they ardse in thelr own countries. Socin Service would also like to draw the ettention of government representetives to the desirability of using the scrvice of non-governantel organizations both in the international sphere and in their respective countries. The non-govermantal organizations can be of assistance in guiding and giving informtion to scholership holders, in proposing cendidates for schol rships to governments and in the assigments of experts.
