The situation in the Middle East

Report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force for the period from 3 March to 28 May 2015 (S/2015/405)

The President: The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda.

Members of the Council have before them document S/2015/474, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by the Russian Federation and the United States of America.

I wish to draw Council members' attention to document S/2015/405, which contains the report

of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force for the period from 3 March to 28 May 2015.

The Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it. I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.

A vote was taken by show of hands.

In favour:

Angola, Chad, Chile, China, France, Jordan, Lithuania, Malaysia, New Zealand, Nigeria, Russian Federation, Spain, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of).

The President: The draft resolution received 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 2229 (2015).
