OFFERS BY MEMBER STATES OF STUDY AND TRAINING FACILITIES
FOR INHABITANTS OF NON-SELF-GOVERNING TERRITORIES

## Report of the Fourth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Mohammed Saeed AL-KINDI (United Arab Emirates)

- 1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 22 September 1989, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its forty-fourth session the item entitled "Offers by Member States of study and training facilities for inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories" and to allocate it to the Fourth Committee.
- 2. At its 2nd meeting, on 2 October, the Fourth Committee decided to hold a general debate covering agenda items 18, 116, 118 and 12, 119 and 120, on the understanding that individual proposals on matters covered by those items would be considered separately.
- 3. The Fourth Committee considered item 120 at its 5th and 9th to 16th meetings, between 10 and 25 October (see A/C.4/44/SR.5, 9-16). The general debate on the items referred to above, including the present item, took place at the 9th to 15th meeting between 18 and 23 October.
- 4. The Fourth Committee had before it the report of the Secretary-General relating to the item (A/44/613 and Add.1).
- 5. At the 16th meeting, on 25 October, the Chairman drew attention to draft resolution A/C.4/44/L.4 which was finally sponsored by Algeria, Argentina, Australia, the Bahamas, Barbados, Brazil, Bulgaria, Burundi, Cameroon, China, Colombia, the Congo, Costa Rica, Cuba, Cyprus, Fiji, Ghana, Guinea, India, Indonesia, Jamaica, Liberia, Madagascar, Mali, New Zealand, Nicaragua, Pakistan,

Papua New Guinea, the Philippines, Samoa, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Sweden, Thailand, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia, Turkey, the United States of America, Vanuatu, Venezuela and Yuqoslavia.

6. At its 16th meeting, on 25 October, the Fourth Committee adopted draft resolution A/C.4/44/L.4 without objection (see para. 7).

## RECOMMENDATION OF THE FOURTH COMMITTEE

7. The Fourth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

Offers by Member States of study and training facilities for inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 43/32 of 22 November 1988,

Having examined the report of the Secretary-General on offers by Member States of study and training facilities for inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories, 1/ prepared pursuant to General Assembly resolution 845 (IX) of 22 November 1954,

<u>Conscious</u> of the importance of promoting the educational advancement of the inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories.

<u>Strongly convinced</u> that the continuation and expansion of offers of scholarships is essential in order to meet the increasing need of students from Non-Self-Governing Territories for educational and training assistance, and considering that students in those Territories should be encouraged to avail themselves of such offers,

- 1. Takes note of the report of the Secretary-General;
- 2. Expresses its appreciation to those Member States that have made scholarships available to the inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories;
- 3. <u>Invites</u> all States to make or continue to make generous offers of study and training facilities to the inhabitants of those Territories that have not yet attained self-government or independence and, wherever possible, to provide travel funds to prospective students;
- 4. <u>Urges</u> the administering Powers to take effective measures to ensure the widespread and continuous dissemination in the Territories under their

administration of information relating to offers of study and training facilities made by States and to provide all the necessary facilities to enable students to avail themselves of such offers;

- 5. Requests the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its forty-fifth session on the implementation of the present resolution;
- 6. <u>Draws the attention</u> of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples to the present resolution.
