REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND EMPLOYMENT COMMISSION
(Fifth Session)

Note by the Secretary-General

The Secretary-General has been requested by the Delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to insert a correction in the report of the fifth session of the Economic and Employment Commission to the Economic and Social Council. The Delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics requested that the report should accurately reflect the reason why the member from the USSR has been unable to take part in the work of the Commission. In its communication the Delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics stated that "in the report of the Economic and Employment Commission (document E/1600) where reference is made to the statement of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics representative the expression 'representative of the Kuomintang' is used instead of 'representative of the Kuomintang group'." 1)

As this report was adopted by the Economic and Employment Commission at its 105th meeting on 30 January 1950, it is not possible for the Secretariat to amend the text. The attention of the members of the Economic and Social Council is, however, drawn to the request of the Delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.
