REPORT OF THE SUB-COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

(Fourth Session)

Note by the Secretary-General

The Secretary-General has been requested by the Delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to insert a correction in the report of the fourth session of the Sub-Commission on Economic Development of the Economic and Employment Commission. The Delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics requested that the report should accurately reflect the reason why Mr. P. M. Chernyshev, an alternate for Mr. A. P. Morosov at the fourth session of the Sub-Commission, has been unable to take part in the work of the Sub-Commission. In its communication the Delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics stated that "in the report of the Sub-Commission on Economic Development (document E/CN.1/Sub.3/29) where reference is made to the resolution and declarations of the expert recommended by the Soviet Union, the expression 'Kuomintang expert' appears instead of 'expert recommended by the Kuomintang group', as actually stated."^{1/}

As this report was adopted by the Sub-Commission on Economic Development at its 78th meeting on 11 May 1950, it is not possible for the Secretariat to amend the text. The attention of the members of the Economic and Social Council is, however, drawn to the request of the Delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.
