Trade embargo against Nicaragua

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolutions 40/188 of 17 December 1985, 41/164 of 5 December 1986, 42/176 of 11 December 1987 and 43/185 of 20 December 1988, as well as its resolutions 42/204 of 11 December 1987, 42/231 of 12 May 1988 and 43/210 of 20 December 1988,

Taking note of the report of the Secretary-General on the trade embargo against Nicaragua, 1/

- 1. <u>Deplores</u> the continuation of the trade embargo contrary to General Assembly resolutions 40/188, 41/164, 42/176 and 43/185 and to the Judgment of the International Court of Justice of 27 June 1986, 2/ and once again requests that those measures be immediately revoked;
- 2. Requests the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its forty-fifth session on the implementation of the present resolution.
