CONSIDERATION OF DRAFT RESOLUTION A/C.1/L.328 AND ADD.1 (continued)

1. Mr. ADEBO (Nigeria) said that certain delegations had indicated that they would like the sponsors of draft resolution A/C.1/L.328 and Add.1 to re-examine certain parts of their text. Since there was a general desire that the draft resolution should obtain the widest possible support, he suggested that the meeting should be adjourned to enable the sponsors to decide what action to take in the matter.

2. The CHAIRMAN said that in the absence of any objection the meeting would be adjourned, and at its afternoon meeting the Committee would take up agenda item 74 (Denuclearization of Latin America).

It was so decided.
