We, the representatives of the States Parties to the Convention on Cluster Munitions, together with representatives from other States present as signatories, the United Nations, the International Committee of the Red Cross and the Cluster Munition Coalition gathered for the First Meeting of States Parties to the Convention in Vientiane, Lao's People's Democratic Republic, one of the most severely affected States, affirm our commitment to end the harm caused by cluster munitions
