REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON RELATIONS WITH THE HOST COUNTRY

Cyprus: draft resolution

Report of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country

The General Assembly,

<u>Having considered</u> the report of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country, $\underline{1}/$

<u>Recalling</u> Article 105 of the Charter of the United Nations, the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations 2/ and the Agreement between the United Nations and the United States of America regarding the Headqua ters of the United Nations, 3/

Recalling also that any problems related to the privileges and immunities of all missions accredited to the United Nations, the security of the missions and the safety of their personnel are of great importance and concern to Member States, as well as the primary responsibility of the host country,

<u>Recognizing</u> that effective measures should continue to be taken by the competent authorities of the host country, in particular to prevent any acts violating the security of missions and the safety of their personnel,

<u>Conscious</u> of the increased interest shown by Member States in participating in the work of the Committee,

1. <u>Endorses</u> the recommendations and conclusions of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country contained in paragraph 45 of its report;

2. <u>Considers</u> that the maintenance of appropriate conditions for the normal work of the delegations and the missions accredited to the United Nations is in the interests of the United Nations and all Member States and urges the host country to continue to take all measures necessary to prevent any interference with the functioning of missions;

3. <u>Expresses its appreciation</u> for the efforts made by the host country and its hope that outstanding problems laised at the meetings of the Committee will be duly settled in a spirit of co-operation and in accordance with international law;

4. <u>Urges</u> the host country, in the light of the consideration by the Committee of travel regulations issued by the host country, to continue to bear in mind its obligations to facilitate the functioning of the United Nations and the missions accredited to it;

5. <u>Stresses</u> the importance of a positive perception of the work of the United Nations, and urges that efforts be continued to build up public awareness by explaining, through all available means, the importance of the role played by the United Nations and the missions accredited to it in the strenghtening of international peace and security;

6. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to remain actively engaged in all aspects of the relations of the United Nations with the host country;

7. <u>Requests</u> the Committee on Relations with the Host Country to continue its work, in conformity with General Assembly resolution 2819 (XXVI) of 15 December 1971;

8. <u>Decides</u> to include in the provisional agenda of its forty-fifth session the item entitled "Report of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country".
