Programme budget implications of draft resolution A/39/L.46Report of the Fifth CommitteeRapporteur: Mr. Ali Achraf MOJTAHED (Islamic Republic of Iran)

1. At its 57th meeting, on 10 April 1985, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/101) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/39/L.46. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR-57).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/39/L.46, conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$224,800. There would be no additional appropriations required.
