Programme budget implications of draft resolution A/39/L.46

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 57th meeting, on 10 April 1985, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/101) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/39/L.46. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR-57).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/39/L.46, conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$224,800. There would be no additional appropriations required.
