Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 58th meeting, on 11 April 1985, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/102) on the programme budget implications of draft decision A/39/L.47. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR.58). The Acting Chairman of the Committee on Conferences made a statement.

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft decision A/39/L.47, conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$133,700. No additional appropriation would be required.
