Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 58th meeting, on 11 April 1985, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/102) on the programme budget implications of draft decision A/39/L.47. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR.58). The Acting Chairman of the Committee on Conferences made a statement.

### DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft decision A/39/L.47, conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$133,700. No additional appropriation would be required.
