1. The CHAIRMAN stated that Cyprus had become a co-sponsor of draft resolution A/SPC/L.101. Draft resolution A/SPC/L.104 had been issued in a revised form (A/SPC/L.104/Rev.1), in which changes had been made in the text of paragraph 1 (b). He reminded the Committee that its reports must be submitted to the General Assembly not later than the following Monday.

2. Mr. CORREA DA COSTA (Brazil), speaking on a point of order, said that the various groups had been meeting regularly since the 423rd meeting but that very few inter-group meetings had taken place. He proposed that the meeting should be adjourned until the following day in order that the situation might be rectified.

*It was so decided.*

3. The CHAIRMAN pointed out that the General Assembly had intended to consider the reports of the Special Political Committee on the question of apartheid and on the three outstanding items at one of its meetings on the following day. In the circumstances, therefore, the Committee must present its report on the latter items not later than Monday, 16 December 1963. Two meetings should therefore be scheduled for the following day and, if necessary, additional meetings should be held over the week-end.
