Corrigendum to the Summary Record of the Sixty-Ninth Meeting

Held at the Palais des Nations, Geneva,
on Tuesday, 25 July 1950 at 10.30 a.m.

Page 19: After Mr. Friis' remarks, insert the following paragraphs:

"Mr. LEDWARD (United Kingdom) drew attention to the fact that there were many precedents for the inclusion of minority views in reports, and said that, if the Chinese representative insisted on the inclusion of his statement, he (Mr. Ledward) would not oppose it.

If, however, the inclusion were agreed upon, he considered that the report should make it absolutely clear that the Committee as a whole did not associate itself with the attitude of the Chinese delegation.

Mr. ROSEMAN (United States of America) supported the United Kingdom representative."
