Corrigendum to Document E/CN.3/SR.46.

1. Mr. DARMOIS (France) requests that the following correction be made to his intervention as reported in the Summary Record of the Forty-Sixth Meeting of the Statistical Commission:

Page 5, line 22:

add the following passage:

"Furthermore, to take only the case of family responsibilities, data on cash allowances gave but a narrow view of the question. Account should also be taken of benefits of other kinds accruing to families, such as tax rebates which did not depend solely on the number of children."

2. Mr. HOFMAN (United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation) requests that the following correction be made to his intervention as reported in the Summary Record of the Forty-Sixth Meeting of the Statistical Commission:

Page 12, line 25:

delete the passage:

"All the international organisation which was inordinately heavy." And replace it by the following version:

"All United Nations organisations should contribute to the cost of the education of statisticians (Document E/CN.3/W.10). Even if the governments concerned paid their share of the costs, the remaining budget would still be too high to be borne by

UNESCO alone".
