DRAFT INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE PROTECTION OF JOURNALISTS ENGAGED IN DANGEROUS **PROFESSIONAL** MISSIONS IN AREAS OF ARMED CONFLICT (continued)

- 1. Mrs. WARZAZI (Morocco) informed the Committee that the informal working group set up to study the draft articles of the international convention on the protection of journalists engaged in dangerous missions (A/8777, annex I; A/C.3/L.1950) and the amendments (A/C.3/L.1951-1961) thereto and to try to work out a text acceptable to the majority had met the previous afternoon but had not been able to complete its task. She therefore requested that the meeting should be adjourned to enable the working group to continue its efforts and bring them to a conclusion.
- 2. The CHAIRMAN said that if he heard no objections, he would take it that the Committee was in agreement that the meeting should be adjourned so that the working group could continue its efforts.
