CHAPTER IV

EXAMINATION OF THE CONCEPT OF FREEDOM OF INFORMATION

In accordance with its terms of reference (document E/CN.4/Sub.1/2), the Sub-Commission began an examination of what rights, obligations and practices should be incluied in the concept of freedom of information. General statements were made by Mr. Chafee (United States), Mr. Christensen (Norway), Mr. Geraud (France), Mr. Goedhart (Netherlands), Mr. Mackenzie (United Kingdom) and Mr. Sychrava (Czechoslovakia). These statements have been published in documents

respectively. The Sub-Commission also took note of Part I of the paper submitted by Mr. R. J. Cruikshank (document E/CN.4/Sub.1/12), the paper submitted by Mr. Sychrava (document E/CN.4/Sub.1/31) and the paper submitted by the Secretariat (document E/CN.4/Sub.1/10, "Constitutional Provisions, International Declarations and Other Statements Concerning Freedom of Information.") Members also noted the probability of further such documentation being submitted. In the light of these considerations, the Sub-Commission adjourned discussion of this subject until its next session. **RECEIVED**
