RESOLUTION OF 25 JUNE 1948 ON TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA

TAKING NOTE that the problems of transport affecting Latin America are of exceptional importance for the economic development of the region and that these problems have already been considered in part by the Transport and Communications Commission and that a report prepared by that body (document E/CN.2/35) will be submitted to the Economic and Social Council for its consideration at its Seventh Session in July 1948;

CONSIDERING that more study of these problems, including among others the question of fair freight rates for the foreign trade of the countries of Latin America, is needed;

RECOMMENDS to the Economic and Social Council that the Transport and Communications Commission be requested to make a further study, including freight rates affecting Latin America, in order to facilitate consideration of these matters as soon as possible by the Economic Commission for Latin America.
