ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA

FIRST SESSION

DRAFT RESOLUTION PRESENTED BY THE REPRESENTATIVE OF GUATEMALA

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA

IN ACCORDANCE with paragraph 15 of the Terms of Reference given by the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations to the Economic Commission for Latin America, and with the generous offer by the Government of Cuba,

RESOLVES:

1. To hold the Second Session of the Commission in Havana, Cuba.
2. That the Executive-Secretary of the Commission, in consultation with the Chairman, shall fix a date, within the first six months of 1949 for the Second Session of the Commission, which shall not coincide with the date of the VIII Session of the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations, and shall follow the Inter-American Conference of Buenos Aires, provided that such Conference is held within the period established, that is, 31 March 1949, by the relevant agreement at Bogota.
