COMMUNICATIONS CONCERNING THE STATUS OF WOMEN (E/CN.6/CR.19)

The CHAIRMAN said that, as document E/CN.6/CR.19 indicated, the Secretary-General had received no non-confidential communications during the period 1 January to 30 November 1966 and consequently there had been no need for the appointment of a special committee.
