DEVELOPMENT AND INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC CO-OPERATION: ENVIRONMENT

Letter dated 22 November 1989 from the President of the General Assembly to the Chairman of the Second Committee

I should like to refer to your letter dated 3 October 1989 (A/C.2/44/9) concerning the question of the Convention on Early Notification of a Nuclear Accident and the Convention on Assistance in the Case of a Nuclear Accident or Radiological Emergency. You advised me in your letter that the Second Committee at its 2nd meeting, on 2 October 1989, had "decided to refer this matter to the General Assembly through the General Committee for appropriate decision concerning its allocation".

As you know, the above-mentioned matter is not listed as an item or sub-item of the agenda of the forty-fourth session of the General Assembly. It has been considered, these past years, under a sub-item entitled "Environment", which has been traditionally allocated to the Second Committee.

In the light of this practice and the fact that, at the current regular session, sub-item 82 (f) on environment has been allocated to the Seconi Committee, I do not consider it necessary to refer the matter to the General Committee. Moreover, to my knowledge there has been no request at this session for a decision on the issue of accession by the United Nations to the International Atomic Energy Agency conventions.

You may wish to bring the above information to the attention of y 'r Committee and to suggest that the Committee defer action on this issue pending a ruture request for its consideration.
