CONSIDERATION OF DRAFT RESOLUTION A/C.4/L.918 AND ADD.1 (concluded)

1. Mr. MAGABANYA (Burundi) said that his delegation had been absent during the vote (1810th meeting) on the draft resolution concerning the question of Oman (A/C.4/L.918 and Add.1), but that if it had been present it would have voted in favour.

2. Mr. TURKSON (Ghana) said that the members of the Afro-Asian group who were sponsoring several draft resolutions were still discussing suggestions from various other delegations regarding the final texts. In order to allow time for further discussions, he proposed that the meeting should be adjourned, under rule 119 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly.

The proposal was adopted by 75 votes to none, with 15 abstentions.
