1. At its 48th meeting, on 27 November 1989, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement of the Secretary-General (A/C.5/44/23) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 7 of its report (A/44/734). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/44/SR.48).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 7 of its report (A/44/734), no additional appropriations would be required under sections 1, 2A, 26 or 27 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1990-1991.
