The meeting was called to order at 5.30 p.m.

Agenda item 5: Election of the officers of the Main Committees

1. **The Chair** said that, in accordance with rule 99 (a) of the rules of procedure, the meeting had been convened for the purpose of electing the Chair and other members of the Bureau of the Committee for the seventieth session of the General Assembly.

2. The nomination of Mr. Logar (Slovenia) for the office of Chair had been endorsed by the Group of Eastern European States. In the absence of further nominations, and in accordance with rule 103 of the rules of procedure, he would take it that the Committee wished to elect Mr. Logar (Slovenia) Chair.

3. *Mr. Logar (Slovenia) was elected Chair by acclamation.*

4. **Mr. Logar** (Slovenia) said that he looked forward to working closely with delegations and with officials from across the United Nations system to help address the challenges and opportunities facing the international community in the coming year, including the negotiations on the post-2015 development agenda, the preparations for the third International Conference on Financing for Development and the twenty-first session of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.

5. **The Chair** said that the nominations of Mr. Chandra (Indonesia), Mr. Carrillo Gómez (Paraguay) and Mr. Krapp (Germany) for the three offices of Vice-Chair had been endorsed by the Group of Asia-Pacific States, the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States and the Group of Western European and Other States, respectively.

6. *Mr. Chandra (Indonesia), Mr. Carrillo Gómez (Paraguay) and Mr. Krapp (Germany) were elected Vice-Chairs by acclamation.*

7. **The Chair** said that the election of the Rapporteur would be held at a later date.
