1. At its 53rd meeting, on 5 December 1989, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General ($\lambda/C.5/44/42$) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution VII recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 78 of its report ($\lambda/44/848$). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman. An oral statement was also made by the Chairman of the Committee on Conferences.

2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/44/SR.53).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution VII recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 78 of its report (A/44/848), no additional appropriations would be required. However, the holding in New York of the meeting of the Working Group on the Drafting of an International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Their Families, as requested in paragraph 3 of the draft resolution, would constitute an exception to the provisions of General Assembly resolution 40/243 of 18 December 1985.
