1. At its 43rd meeting, on 17 November 1989, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/44/28) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 13 of its report (A/44/736). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/44/SR.43).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 13 of its report (A/44/736), no additional appropriations would be required under either section 23 or section 29 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1990-1991. The Committee also decided to inform the General Assembly that, should it decide to approve the payment of emoluments referred to in the draft resolution, the amount as suggested by the Secretary-General would be \$32,000.
