Programme budget implications of draft resolution III recommended by the Third Committee in its report (A/44/850, para. 35)

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 53rd meeting, on 5 December 1989, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/44/40) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution III recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 35 of its report (A/44/850). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/44/SR.53).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

- 3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution III recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 35 of its report (A/44/850):
- (a) Additional resource requirements of \$82,900 would have to be met under section 20 (International drug control) of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1990-1991 in respect of operative paragraph 9 of the draft resolution;

- (b) Such requirements would constitute an additional expenditure derived from legislative mandates not provided for in the proposed programme budget for 1990-1991 and would therefore be subject to the guidelines for the use of the contingency fund approved by the General Assembly in its resolution 42/211 of 21 December 1987;
- (c) In the event that the additional expenditure cannot be financed from the contingency fund, the Secretary-General would defer to the biennium 1992-1993 two of the seven meetings of the expert groups envisaged in paragraph 20.18 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1990-1991 in connection with the programme of work of the Division of Narcotic Drugs.
- 4. The Committee also decided to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of draft resolution III recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 35 of its report (A/44/850) would be subject to the understanding spelled out in paragraph 3 (b) and (c) above, in accordance with Assembly resolution 42/211, and that such additional appropriations as may be requested by the Secretary-General will be in the context of a consolidated statement to be submitted to the General Assembly towards the end of its current session in accordance with resolution 42/211, annex, section C, paragraphs 5 and 6.
