Programme budget implications of draft resolution A/70/L.38: Organization of the 2016 High-level Meeting on HIV/AIDS (A/70/7/Add.40; A/C.5/70/20)

1. **Mr. Huisman** (Director, Programme Planning and Budget Division), introducing the statement submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly of the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/70/L.38: Organization of the 2016 High-level Meeting on HIV/AIDS (A/C.5/70/20), said that it was proposed that an additional appropriation of \$118,200 under section 2, General Assembly and Economic and Social Council affairs and conference management, of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2016-2017 should be approved as a charge against the contingency fund.

2. **Mr. Ruiz Massieu** (Chair of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions), introducing the related report of the Advisory Committee (A/70/7/Add.40), said that the Advisory Committee recommended that the General Assembly should request the Secretary-General to make every effort to absorb the additional requirements of \$118,200 proposed under section 2 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2016-2017. If they could not be absorbed, the additional expenditure should be reflected in the performance report for the biennium.
