I INTRODUCTION

- 1. The item entitled "Comprehensive approach to strengthening international peace and security in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations" was included in the provisional agenda of the forty-fourth session in accordance with General Assembly resolution 43/89 of 7 December 1988.
- 2. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 22 September 1989, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the First Committee.
- 3. The general debate on and consideration of agenda item 73 took place jointly with items 71 and 72 between the 46th and 52nd meetings, from 22 to 30 November (see A/C.1/44/PV.46-52).
