LETTER TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FROM THE  
SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE  
SECURITY COUNCIL ON MONDAY, 4 NOVEMBER 1946 AT ITS  
SEVENTY-NINTH MEETING

4 November 1946

Sir,

In accordance with the provisions of Article 12, Paragraph 2,  
of the Charter, I have the honour to inform you that, at its  
seventy-ninth meeting held on Monday, 4 November 1946, the Security  
Council adopted the following resolution:

"The Security Council resolves that the situation in  
Spain be taken from the list of matters of which the  
Council is seized and that all records and documents  
of the case be put at the disposal of the  
General Assembly. The Security Council requests the  
Secretary-General to notify the General Assembly of  
this decision."
