LETTER DATED 9 JANUARY 1990 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO
THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government and pursuant to our numerous letters concerning Iraqi violations of the cease-fire, I have the honour to submit a list of further violations of the cease-fire by Iraqi forces. The numerical sequences of these violations follows the sequence of those previously reported.

2343. On 16 September 1989, a bunker was constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of ND 833-801 on the map of Sardasht.

2344. On 16 September 1989, a bunker was constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of PD 089-955 on the map of Nowsud.

2345. On 17 September and 20 September 1989, at 1730 to 1800 hours, Iraqi forces on two occasions fired mortars and artillery towards Iranian forces. The violations occurred in the vicinity of hill 2050 at the geographic co-ordinates of NF 211-218, NF 290-232 and NF 243-21G on the map of Alavan.

2346. On 17 September 1989, a group bunker was constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 30-86 on the map of Sardasht.

2347. On 17 September 1989, Iraqi forces fired a few rounds of 106 mm shells at the geographic co-ordinates of ND 668-415 on the map of Qasr-e-Shirin.

2348. On 17 September 1989, an observation post was constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of QB 221-011 on the map of Dehloran.

2349. On 17 September 1989, Iraqi forces fired four rounds of flares in the general area of Talul-al-Hadiat at the geographic co-ordinates of QV 86-31 on the map of Hadadieh Hills.

2350. On 18 September 1989, at 0800 hours, Iraqi forces set up a minefield and installed barbed wire at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 551-781 on the map of Sizdeh.

2351. On 18 September 1989, at 1830 hours, a rest bunker was constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 573-542 on the map of Sumar.
2352. On 18 September 1989, at 1030 and 1800 hours, Iraqi forces fired four rounds by Dush-k heavy machine-gun at two different times at the geographic co-ordinates of TP 70500-14000 on the map of Nahr-e-Alishir.
2353. On 18 September 1989, a group bunker was constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of NF 2815-0465 on the map of Sardasht.
2354. On 18 September 1989, at 1430 and 1620 hours, an Iraqi plane was observed flying towards the Islamic Republic of Iran and returning back towards Iraq after some hours.
2355. On 18 September 1989, Iraqi forces set up minefields and installed barbed wire at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 551-781 on the map of Sizdeh.
2356. On 18 September 1989, two ambush bunkers were constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 64-27 on the map of Kanishikh.
2357. On 18 September 1989, Iraqi forces dug trenches at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 075-980 on the map of Meimeh river.
2358. On 18 September 1989, a bunker was constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 338-919 on the map of Meimeh-e-Anbar.
2359. On 18 September 1989, three Iraqi planes were observed at a high altitude in the south at the geographic co-ordinates of QV 66-27 on the map of Talul.
2360. On 19 September 1989, a group bunker was constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 9060-3360 on the map of Panjwein.
2361. On 19 September 1989, bunkers were constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 84-65 on the map of Baneh.
2362. On 19 September 1989, at 1820 hours, two observation posts at a distance of 100 m from each other were constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 96-08 on the map of Serni.
2363. On 19 September 1989, two bunkers were constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of 978-857 on the map of Nowsud.
2364. On 19 September 1989, at 1430 hours, a trench was dug at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 286-955 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.
2365. On 20 September 1989, at 0900 hours, a weapon position was constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 9100-4145 on the map of Marivan.

2366. On 20 September 1989, two ambush bunkers were constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 64-27 on the map of Kanishikh.

2367. On 20 September 1989, Iraqi forces constructed two bunkers at the geographic co-ordinates of PE 064-940 on the map of Nowsud.

2368. On 20 September 1989, at 1820 hours, seven Iraqi infantry personnel dug trenches at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 286-962 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.

2369. On 21 September 1989, at 1900 hours, a communication trench was dug at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 8875-3930 on the map of Panjwein.

2370. On 21 September 1989, at 1700 hours, Iraqi infantrymen constructed a bunker at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 83-65 on the map of Baneh.

2371. On 21 September 1989, at 1520 hours, Iraqi forces dug a communication trench at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 503-692 on the map of Sizdeh.

2372. On 21 September 1989, at 0530 and 0900 hours, two firing bunkers were constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 573-456 and NC 573-452 on the map of Sumar.

2373. On 21 September 1989, two group bunkers were constructed at the geographic co-ordinates of QB 204-014 and QB 207-018 on the map of Dehloran.

2374. On 21 September 1989, Iraqi infantry forces constructed four bunkers at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 348-914, QA 348-915, QA 348-916, QA 348-917 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.

2375. On 21 September 1989, at 1720 hours, a communication trench was dug by Iraqi infantrymen at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 285-961 and QA 299-951 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.

2376. On 21 September 1989, at 1120 hours, a communication trench was dug at the geographic co-ordinates of 324-930 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.

2377. On 21 September 1989, at 0100 hours, four Iraqi infantry personnel constructed bunkers at the geographic co-ordinates of PB 135-748 on the map of Mehran.

2378. On 22 September 1989, at 1630 hours, Iraqi infantrymen constructed a new observation post at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 83-65 on the map of Baneh.

2379. On 22 September 1989, Iraqi forces were seen planting mines at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 562-794 on the map of Garmab.

2380. On 22 September 1989, Iraqi infantrymen were observed digging a communication trench at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 298-953 and QA 299-952 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.
