Acting in pursuance of General Assembly resolution 119 (II) and

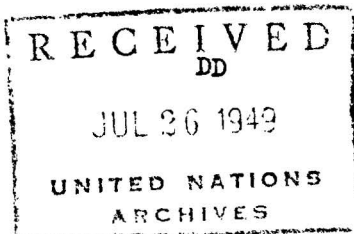
Having noted the report of the Secretary-General and the replies of Governments contained in E/1325 and E/963 and Addenda,

THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Urges all Governments to reply fully and in good time to the questions submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance with the foregoing resolutions of the General Assembly and the Council, and

Decides to establish a working group of the following nine members of the Council (.....) to sit between the ninth and tenth sessions to examine the replies received from Governments in document E/963 and Addenda and the Report of the Secretary-General (E/1325) and report before the end of 1949, and in particular;

- (a) to comment on the form of the replies so far received and to recommend methods of securing more useful results in future by improving the procedure for collecting the information or in other ways;
- (b) to indicate those resolutions on which no further reports will be required;
- (c) to indicate, if appropriate, any resolution to which the Council might further direct its attention because the



replies show that it is not being carried out or that further action is required;

- (d) to report generally on the question of the implementation of Council and Assembly decisions and on the form and frequency of the Council's report to the General Assembly;
- (e) to recommend, in the light of the foregoing examination, means whereby the Council can improve its procedures so that more effective action is taken as a result of Council and Assembly decisions.
