## Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 60th meeting, on 20 December 1989, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/44/53) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution V recommended by the Second Committee in section III of its report (A/44/746/Add.7). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution V recommended by the Second Committee in section III of its report (A/44/746/Add.7), no additional appropriations would be required at this stage.
