

TRUSTEESHIP AGREEMENTS

Addendum to Report of the Fourth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Karel LISICKY (Czechoslovakia)

Add the following in Annex IV of this document:

Mr. LISICKY (CZECHOSLOVAKIA) declared that he would vote against the agreements. This position should be taken as indicating a desire that the General Assembly should take serious account of the position of the Delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics concerning Article 79 of the Charter, before taking a decision which would be irrevocable.

Mr. BADAWI (EGYPT) stated that his Government would support the acceptance of the Trusteeship agreements, but he wished to make it clear that Egypt considered herself directly concerned, under Article 79 of the Charter, in the possible placing under Trusteeship of Arab territories which were under mandate and in the possible submission of territories to the Trusteeship System, under Article 77 (b) and (c).

Mr. WORM-MULLER (NORWAY) stated that, although he had supported the deletion of the phrase "as an integral part" and the insertion of the provision concerning revision of the Trusteeship agreements, these provisions were not so essential that the agreements could not be accepted. Consequently, he was prepared to vote for them.

Mr. LOVERA (VENEZUELA) while wishing not to repeat the arguments set forth by several other Delegates, said that his Delegation would vote in favour of the Trusteeship agreements, taking into account, in particular, the reasons so clearly explained by the Delegate for Mexico.
