LETTER DATED 23 MAY 1985 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF INDIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

The Extraordinary Ministerial Meeting of the Co-ordinating Bureau of Non-aligned Countries on the question of Namibia, held in New Delhi from 19 to 21 April 1985, has called for "an urgent meeting of the United Nations Security Council to resume its consideration of the question of Namibia and to give effect to its own resolutions in this regard, in particular Security Council resolution 435 (1978)". Accordingly, on behalf of the Movement of Non-aligned Countries, I have the honour to request you to convene the Security Council to further consider the situation in Namibia.
