Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

Note verbale dated 1 June 2016 from the Permanent Mission of Australia to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

By paragraph 40 of its resolution 2270 (2016), the Security Council called upon all States to report to the Council within 90 days of the adoption of the resolution, and thereafter upon request by the Committee, on concrete measures that they had taken in order to implement effectively the provisions of the resolution.

Paragraph 10 of the resolution, designating individuals and entities listed in annexes I and II to the resolution, is automatically implemented in Australia by the Charter of the United Nations (Sanctions — Democratic People's Republic of Korea) Regulation 2008.

The Government of Australia is currently preparing new regulations to give effect to the measures outlined in the remaining paragraphs of the resolution. However, given that the Prime Minister has announced an election for both houses of Parliament on 2 July 2016, the Government is currently subject to the caretaker conventions until the outcome of the election is known. This means that the new regulations will be implemented after the election.
