## Subject: Education grant and special education grant for disabled children

1. The purpose of the present circular is to advise staff members of the decision of the General Assembly, in its resolution 68/253, to introduce a special education grant measure that allows the reimbursement of education-related expenses up to the maximum established for the United States dollar inside the United States zone for three English-curriculum schools in Brussels, namely, the International School of Brussels, the British School of Brussels and St. John's International School, as from the academic year in progress on 1 January 2013.
2. The additional special measure is reflected in the table contained in the annex to the present circular.
3. The present circular supersedes information circular ST/IC/2013/14 of 19 April 2013.
